- Please use the antibiotic drops four (4) times a day for four (4) days.
- Paracetamol may be taken if necessary.

You may notice any of the following over the next two (2) days:

- Foreign body sensation or grittiness of the eye; this can be quite severe in the
  first few hours after the treatment if you have accidentally opened the eye under
  the pad and have scratched the cornea (front window of the eye). This usually
  heals within 24 hours.
- Redness of the eye.
- Blurry vision.

 Floaters or "blobs" in your vision; these will become smaller and disappear over a few weeks.

You will be given an appointment for your next check or next injection if necessary at reception before leaving.

Please report if you have any of the following:

- Severe pain
- Marked worsening of vision or loss of vision.
